### **Reading Pope Francis in 21<sup>a</sup> Journey of the Religious Life**

The temptation of survival makes us forget grace, makes us professionals of the sacred, but not fathers, mothers or brothers of hope that we have been called to prophesy. That survival environment dries the hearts of our elders depriving them of the ability to dream and, in this way, sterilizes the prophecy that the youngest are called to announce and fulfill. In short, the temptation of survival transforms into danger, threat, tragedy, what the Lord presents as an opportunity for mission. This attitude is not exclusive to consecrated life, but in particular we are invited to take care not to fall into it.

6. Am I afraid of the future and that makes me leave the present?
